

MINUTES: Motion by Ladd, second by Jarvela, to approve the minutes of the January 21, 2012 Council meeting as printed. Motion carried.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Motion by Warren, second by Hebert, to approve the Treasurer's Report as printed. Motion carried.

Trustees Ongoing monthly maintenance to Church and LFOJ completed. 2013 lease agreement for signs on Sanborn and Highway 13 were received from City of Ashland and filed. Old microwave from LFOJ was donated to Jesse's used appliance store. Trustees and Men's Club serve Soup and Sandwiches on 2/27 with proceeds helping to defray the costs of cancer treatments for Ken Philaja.

- Little Friends of Jesus Jule Jarvela joined the LFOJ board; LFOJ alumni, Sarah Johnson, will be completing her Early Childhood practicum in the preschool room; looking to replace carpet and linoleum
- **Evangelism** Many projects in the works, continuing to look at placing a sign on 11th Street parking lot, considering 'Reaching Rural America for Christ' leadership program as a main focus and mission, which includes a community outreach/awareness. Considering ways to bring people into the church (opening Lenten soup and sandwiches to the community and advertising it as such in the paper, quarterly public workshops on elderly care, gambling, divorce, grieving, etc;)
- **Deacon's Report** Pastor Peterson from Concordia University of Wisconsin will be giving the sermon message and bible study on 2/24/13; LFOJ chapel and Lenten services going well; Has caught up on visitations; Rick is completing the application for the Specific Ministry Program and getting his transcripts from Concordia-Mequon to St. Louis Seminary. Rick shared that confirmation is going well and he is very pleased by the progress of the students and the depth of their questions.
